Listening to Student Needs

Knowledge and literacy are the main goals of students in the learning process. To raise their Interest in increasing this process of mastering is a matter of time, pedagogical responsibility, mentorship. These four principles are the power and rank of a person. If we remove the number 1 ahead, there will be left only zeroes. Hence, Good Manners play an important role in a person's prestige. Unless we don't know how to behave, we will lose everything we achieve in life, and our efforts will be worth zero.



Then our rector answered the students' suggestions and questions clearly and concisely. The students also were grateful to the rector for his sincere dialogue and frankness. This is how we can go from a strong state to a strong civil society. At the end of the event, Vice-Rector for Youth Affairs of the Institute Ruzimurot Choriev held a practical discussion on the needs of students.
