## At the HUMO ARENA ice complex

Construction of the Ice Palace "Humo Arena" in Tashkent Bunyodkor and many Uzbeks believe that the construction of a closed ice stadium in Tashkent will help the development of winter sports that Uzbekistan has not so far demonstrated in international competitions. In the area around the complex, they received information about a multi-storey parking, a recreational zone for family recreation.

The new multifunctional ice complex is an exclusive project for Uzbekistan and nowadays it has been nominated for the title of the most magnificent sports and cultural center of the city.
