Awarding the winners of the competition

For the first time, International Day of Rural Women was celebrated on October 15, 2008. Officially proclaimed by General Assembly resolution 62/136 dated 18 December 2007, "the vital role of rural women, including indigenous women, and their contribution to accelerating agricultural and rural development, improving food security and the eradication of rural poverty".



This date is consonant with the systemic reforms being carried out in the republic in order to provide full support for women, increase their socio-political activity, and create decent working and living conditions.
