

Students of the Bukhara branch of TIAME in "Jeyran" nursery

Under the guidance of the teacher of the Department of Hydrology and Ecology of the Bukhara branch of the TIAME Kabulova Barno, the 2nd year students of the direction "Ecology and Environmental Protection" visited the Bukhara specialized nursery "Jeyran", located in the Karaulbazar region. B. Kobulova told the students about the conditions in the nursery "Jeyran". The total area is 16 522 hectares, where such rare animals as gazelle, Turkmen kulan, Bukhara mountain deer and reindeer are bred.



The protected area of the nursery is 5,145 hectares, and the open area is 11,377 hectares. In order to further develop ecotourism in the region, in the Bukhara specialized nursery "Jeyran" it is planned to build a building for 20 places special for tourists. For reference, about 50 species of vertebrates and 6 species of invertebrates inhabiting the territory of the Bukhara specialized nursery "Jeyran" are included in the "Red Book" of the Republic of Uzbekistan.
