

## Visit to Zangiota complex

Abdukadirova, visited the Zangiota complex. Zangiota is a historical and architectural monument of the XIV century in Tashkent region. It is well known and popular not only in our country, but also among the peoples of Central Asia. This is the resting place of Sheikh Ai-Khoja, nicknamed Zangi-ata ("black") - the fifth murid of the great Sufi, the founder of the Khojagan order, Khoja Ahmad Yassavi, and the spiritual disciple of the famous mystic poet Suleiman Khaki-ata Bakyrangani.
