5 + 1 system implementation in practice

The President of the Republic of Uzbekistan signed the Decree "On approval of the Concept of development of higher education of the Republic of Uzbekistan until 2030". It includes:

- development of public-private partnerships in the field of higher education, increasing the level of higher education coverage by more than 50 percent based on the organization in the regions of activity of state and non-state higher educational institutions, creation of a healthy competitive environment;
- phased transfer of the educational process of higher educational institutions to the credit-modular system;
- introduction of advanced standards of higher education, in particular, a phased transition from education, whose curriculum is aimed at obtaining theoretical knowledge, to an educational system aimed at developing practical skills based on international experience.



The institute is actively working to improve the quality of education. In particular, in accordance with protocol No. 6 of paragraph 12 of September 30, 2019, the institute introduces student training in the 5+1 system (five days at the institute and one day at the factory). On October 8, the faculty of the department of energy supply and renewable energy sources Sh. Muzafarov, A. Sanbetova, A. Babayev and A. Davyrov together with the groups held a practical lesson in the unitary enterprise "Uzteletarmoq" located on the Keles substation $220/110/10 \, \text{sg}$.
