

## Memorandum

Tashkent Institute of Irrigation and Agricultural Mechanization Engineers and the Uzbekistan branch of the United Nation's Food and Agriculture Organization signed the memorandum of cooperation for the first time to establish the scientific-theoretical and practical relationship. One of the main goals of the memorandum, signed on 29 August this year, is to create a cluster for widespread introduction of land reclamation technologies, namely, resource-saving technologies for soil protection.
