

## Congratulations

Press Secretary of TIAME, Candidate of Philology, Associate Professor Rakhimboy Matkarimovich Djumaniyazov celebrated his 60th birthday. The management of the Institute sincerely congratulates him on this anniversary. Here is a summary of it. In 1979 Jumaniyazov R.M. entered the faculty of Uzbek philology of the Tashkent State University, and in 1984 graduated with honors. On November 13, 1991, he defended his Ph.D. thesis on the topic "Uzbek folk books researching in historical aspects" Yusuf and Akhmad "historical base of dastan" (10.00.08 - "Folklore"). On the basis of Protocol No. 12 of November 13, 1991, on the recommendation of the Specialized Council of the Institute of Literature named after Alisher Navoi of the Supreme Attestation Commission under the Council of Ministers of the USSR, he was awarded the degree of candidate of philological sciences ( No. 051951).



R.M. Jumaniyazov worked as a senior researcher at the Institute of Language and Literature of the Academy of Sciences of Uzbekistan, head of the department of Uzbek language and literature at the Tashkent State Institute of Arts, head of the Yogdu department in the Marifat studio of the National TV and Radio Company of Uzbekistan, head of the department of television and radio broadcasting at the Faculty of Journalism of the National University of Uzbekistan, associate professor of the Tashkent State Institute of Culture, correspondent of the newspaper "Vakt-Vremya" of the Main Directorate for the Execution of Punishment of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan. He currently works as an assistant professor at the Tashkent Institute of Irrigation and Agricultural Mechanization Engineers and is the head of the press service.



R.M. Jumaniyazov worked at the Institute for Strategic Studies as a chief information officer since 2017, and then carried out his activities as a press secretary. He took an active part in the socio-political and spiritual life of the country, in particular, he contributed to the promotion and implementation of the State Language Law. R.M. Jumaniyazov is a leading and active participant in a number of programs on Uzbek television.



He has published over 20 books and about 300 articles. His book "Old Uzbek Writing" has been used since 1991 as a textbook in higher educational institutions. The book "Academy of Oratory" is an important aid in teaching the culture of communication and interpersonal communication.

Today he lectures and conducts seminars "Mechanism of management, speech culture, and speech skills" in the institutions of the Ministry of Public Education, divisions of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, structures of the State Security Service, the Center for the Training of Lawyers, the Higher School of Judges, the Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Republic.



R.M. Jumaniyazov takes an active part in the media and in social networks when covering the innovative changes taking place in the educational process at TIAME. It is also noteworthy that he developed and introduced into practice a mechanism for simple and understandable informing the population about the essence of official laws, decisions, decrees, and orders, as well as about positive changes in the educational process and the communicative competence of the teacher. It is noteworthy that he took an

active part in a television program dedicated to the Uzbek writing based on the Arabic and Latin alphabets, published an article on this topic "Teacher of the Republic".
