The procedure for admitting citizens with at least five years of work experience in the economy for part-time education on a paid basis, differentiated according to the results of the interview.

According to the conclusion of the meeting of the State Commission for Admission to Educational Institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. 1 dated July 4, 2019, based on the results of interviews of citizens with at least five years of work experience in the economy. admission approved on the basis of a stratified service fee agreement.

The first person who personally gives recommendations to employees (except for technical personnel) who have worked as a main place of work in the system of ministries, departments and large business associations for at least five years, based on the main areas of activity of these ministries. , departments and large business associations being addressed.

Based on the results of the interview, it is recommended to study in part-time and evening forms of study, payment of contractual funds for the training of an applicant (5 years for part-time studies, 4 years for evening studies), payment within the terms established by the operating organization (ministry, department or large business association).

Applicants applying will be able to register online through the website of the State Testing Center (GTZ).

It is planned to integrate the database of applicants recommended by the ministry, agency or large business association into a special program of the State Testing Center (GTZ).

The first heads of ministries, agencies or large business associations are responsible for ensuring that recommendations are presented fairly and transparently.

The procedure for admission of applicants for the second and further education

According to the conclusion of the meeting of the State Commission for admission to educational institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated August 13, 2008 No. 15 (from the state register of the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated August 21, 2008 No. 1844) Regulations on the procedure for obtaining a second and further education in educational institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

According to this Regulation, education in the second and subsequent higher education is carried out on a paid (contract) basis.

Persons with higher education can obtain the following second and subsequent higher education:

- bachelors and graduates in higher education;
- Individuals with a master's degree in undergraduate and related master's programs.

A list of educational institutions that have the right to train personnel for the second and subsequent higher education, as well as their admission to higher educational institutions by the State Commission for admission to educational institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan, has been determined.

Applicants for the second and subsequent higher education for the current academic year are accepted through the online platform of the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Specialized Education ikkinchitalim.edu.uz

The admissions committee of an educational institution has the right to conduct tests in the form and order agreed with the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Specialized Education of the Republic of

Uzbekistan in order to assess the level of knowledge of applicants.
